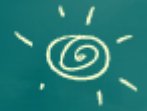




CMCP holds Family Fun Festival and Moves to a "Home of Its Own"

Important Facts and Dates

St Raymonds School: will reopen after labour day. No changes expected.

706 College Street Site will remain open until our final move which is expected in November/December. It will move to the CMCP OEYC permanent location at Artscape Youngplace, lower level, 180 Shaw Street as soon as our renovations are complete.



Site on Clinton at St Francis school: The last day of programming at this site will be Friday September 13th. This site will be closed permanently as of Sept 16th. Programs and services will be offered at Givens Shaw School at 49 Givens Rm 55 starting September 30th.

New Temporary OEYC Site at Givens Shaw School 49 Givens St. Room 55 will open September 30th. This location will remain open until work is completed in our permanent site and we can move into the Artscape Youngplace lower level. We are very happy to welcome families who have been participants of the Parenting and Family Literacy Centre at this school as well as all the Trinity-Spadina OEYC Families.

Artscape Youngplace 180 Shaw St our permanent head office and OEYC location will open some time in November/December. Our contractors begin work next week and we are told it will take approximately 12 weeks.
