We are currently seeking to fill 3 Volunteer Board Member and Committee positions. Board members are responsible for strategic oversight of CMCP operations and ensuring sustainability and excellence in service. Interested and qualified individuals who are passionate about community service are encouraged to apply. Priority will be given to applicants representing the equity seeking groups we serve, including BIPOC. Preference will be given to those candidates with experience volunteering and/or working in a non-profit environment plus expertise in Human Resources, Law, Finance and Accounting, and Community Development.

The current gap in skills on the board and committees that we are recruiting for are:

1. Position of Treasurer on the board.
2. Fundraising experience for our development committee and board.
3. DEI and program evaluation experience for our program committee and board.

Please note this is a volunteer position and requires a commitment of a minimum of 6 hours/year.

CMCP board members are required to sit on a standing committee. Board members are elected at our AGM for a 2-year term.
